Applications to work as an Election Official at one of the polling locations for the 2026 Municipal Election are now being accepted at [elections@bayham.on.ca](mailto:elections@bayham.on.ca) to perform the statutory duties as required in accordance with the Municipal Elections Act.

To be considered for a position, applicants must possess the following requirements, knowledge and skills, and be willing to carry out the core responsibilities of the position:

- Knowledge of the *Municipal Elections Act* is an asset.
- Must attend the mandatory workshop/training session held by the Municipality concerning the Municipal Election – Strathroy Community Centre, Thursday October 8, 2026 – 6PM
- Good computer skills.
- Previous Election experience is an asset.
- Assist with voter inquiries in regard to the Municipal Elections Act.
- 18 years or older
- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- Cannot be a candidate, related to a candidate, campaigning for a candidate or providing an endorsement signature to a candidate running in the October 26, 2026, Municipal Election

Successful applicants will be required to work an Election Day Poll on October 26<sup>th</sup> from 10AM – 8PM. Additionally, applicants will be required to assist with counting and setting up and taking down the poll before and after the time listed. Remuneration for selected applicants, which includes attendance at the mandatory training session, is as follows:

- **Deputy Returning Officer - \$270.00**
- **Election Assistant - \$230.00**
- **Poll Clerk - \$245.00**
- **Revisions Clerk - \$245.00**

The deadline to submit an application to work as an Election Official at one of the polling locations is October 2, 2026 at 4:00PM. Job descriptions for each position are attached to this ad.
