Qualified Opinion

I have audited the Financial Statement of Dave Wrobel, candidate, which comprises the Statement of Campaign Income and Expenses, the Calculation of Surplus or Deficit, and the attached Schedules of Contributions, and Fundraising Events and Activities, and a covering page with candidate information relating to the election held on October 24, 2022. This financial information has been prepared by the candidate, in accordance with the accounting requirements of sections 88.8 through 88.32 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.

In my opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion section of my report, the accompanying Financial Statement of Dave Wrobel for the campaign period from May 20, 2022 to January 3, 2023 is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the accounting requirements of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of electoral campaigns, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to my obtaining evidence I considered necessary for the purposes of the review. Accordingly, the evidence obtained of these contributions and other revenue and expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in the campaign accounting records of Dave Wrobel. Therefore I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions and other revenue and expenses. My conclusion on the Financial Statement for the campaign period was modified accordingly because of the possible effects of this limitation in scope.

I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. My responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement section of my report. I am independent of Dave Wrobel in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to my audit of financial statements in Canada, and I have fulfilled my other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my qualified opinion.

The Candidate's Responsibility for the Financial Statement

The candidate is responsible for the preparation of the Financial Statement in accordance with the provisions of sections 88.8 through 88.32 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* and for such internal control as the candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the financial statement free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility for the Audit of the Financial Statement

My objective is to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Financial Statement as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes my opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, I exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. I also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement in the Financial Statement, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the candidate's campaign internal control.

- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the candidate.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the Financial Statement, and whether the Financial Statement represents the underlying transactions and events in a manner consistent with the accounting requirements of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.

Basis of Accounting

Without modifying my qualified opinion, I draw attention to the basis of accounting of the Financial Statement, which is that presented in Form 4 as prescribed under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*. As a result, the Financial Statement may not be suitable for another purpose.

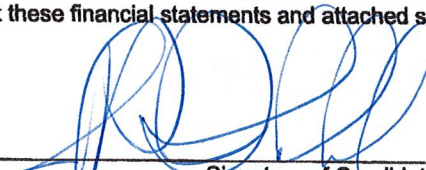

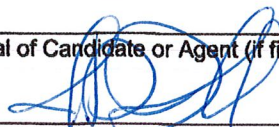

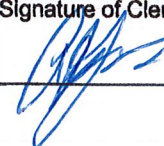
