- Litigation or potential litigation affecting the board, including matters before administrative tribunals – CSPA Section 44 (2) (e) and Information that Section 8 of the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act would authorize a refusal to disclose if it were contained in a record – CSPA Section 44 (2) (k)
