Discussion Questions

You with the Sad Eyes by Christina Applegate

1. What was your overall impression of *You with the Sad Eyes*? Which aspects of Applegate's story were most surprising or impactful?
2. She describes work as a refuge. Has your career or personal work ever served as a retreat or distraction from life's challenges?
3. Did the book challenge any of your preconceived notions or beliefs? If so, how did it reshape your views?
4. Applegate explores the complexity of working at a young age to support her family. Was there a time when you had to take on significant responsibility before you were ready? How did this responsibility impact you in positive or negative ways?
5. Applegate's relationships with her parents impacted her sense of self. Which of Applegate's familial relationships resonates most with your own experience? How have your parental dynamics influenced your self-regard, and why?
6. Were there moments where you found yourself judging Applegate's actions or decisions? How would you have reacted in their position?
7. Imagine you are adapting Applegate's memoir into a documentary film. Which scenes or anecdotes which you include, and which key figures would you interview?
8. Applegate explores work as a refuge. Compare and contrast her work story to your own. Has your career offered you a retreat or distraction from reality?
9. What lessons about self-acceptance, perseverance, and advocacy for mental and physical health can readers take from her story?
