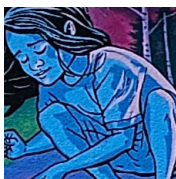

The mural's idea captured the magic of childhood, the mesmerizing glow of the northern lights, and the city's connection to its Birch Hills heritage.

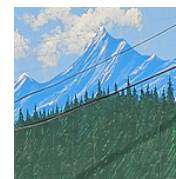


EVERY CHILD MATTERS

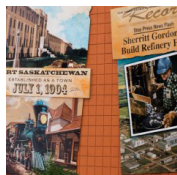

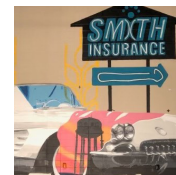


FORT ON THE SASKATCHEWAN

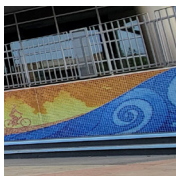


WASH LAND TRAIN

Inspired by the historic "Fort Turn," this mural celebrates Fort Saskatchewan's railway and industrial heritage.

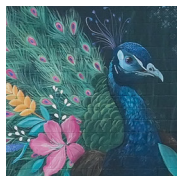


CURRENTS
