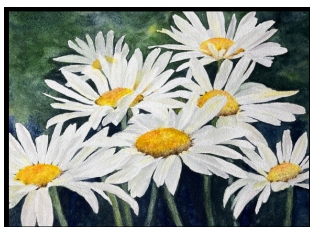


Art for Art's Sake

Elk Island Art Club

The Elk Island Art Club, whose members have strong connections to the City of Fort Saskatchewan, are pleased to present a selection of artistic creations. Club members with a wide range of experience are brought together by the joy of immersing themselves in the process of creating art.

The Elk Island Art Club is a small club that began in Strathcona County in the 1950's. The members meet Tuesday afternoons in Josephburg to paint and critique their finished pieces and works-in-progress. It is through these discussions that members feel they most benefit from the art club. All members, beginner to expert, contribute their advice and experience in various media, including oil, acrylic, watercolour, fibre, pencil, ink, pastels, as well as sculpture. This enables them to promote art in the community. Over seventy years later, this art club's mandate has not changed.



The Club presents an annual art show at their location in Josephburg. They also participate in events such as Christmas in the Heartland, Josephburg Ag Society's Dinner Concert Series, the Bison Festival at Elk Island National Park and Harvest of the Past at the Ukrainian Cultural Heritage Village. The Club also has opportunities to exhibit in Fort Saskatchewan, Sherwood Park, Chipman, and Edmonton.
