Bylaw 2026-031

To Establish A Joint Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee and Appoint Members

Whereas subsection 88.37 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as amended requires Council to establish a Compliance Audit Committee before October 1 of an election year for the purposes set out in the Act;

And Whereas Section 88.37 (5) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as amended, states the term of office of the committee is the same as the term of office of the council or local board that takes office following the next regular election, and the term of office of the members of the committee is the same as the term of the committee to which they have been appointed;

And Whereas the County of Hastings member Municipalities deem it expedient to establish a Joint Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee for all municipalities in the County of Hastings;

Now Therefore The Council of The Corporation of The Municipality of Hastings Highlands Enacts As Follows:

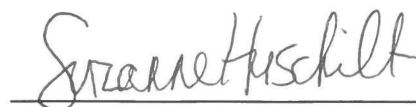
- 1) That the Municipality of Hastings Highlands establishes a Joint Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee with the County of Hastings member Municipalities for 2026-2030 in accordance with the Terms of Reference, attached hereto as Schedule 'A'.
- 2) That the following persons are hereby appointed to the Joint Hastings County Compliance Audit Committee from November 15, 2026 until November 14, 2030:

Tom Veaudry

- 3) That the Terms of Reference for the Joint Hastings County Compliance Audit Committee shall be attached hereto as Schedule 'A' to this Bylaw.
- 4) That Bylaw 2022-057 and 2024-038 is hereby repealed.
- 5) That this Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of its final passing.
