15. **"The North Star"** – The North Star is one of the brightest stars of the night sky and it always points North. In an attempt to be free, black slaves in the southern United States travelled north to Canada on the Underground Railroad using specific quilting patterns as a secret code to guide their journey. In this secret code, the pattern of the North Star told the slaves to keep heading North to Canada. Since our house is located where travellers

would first step onto Canadian mainland, we thought it fitting to proudly show this quilt square as a symbol that they have finally arrived in Canada, and are now free.
