Scan to find your property's collection schedule.

Garbage will be collected bi-weekly (every other week). You need to know if your property will be collected week 1 or week 2. Scan the QR code to find your property's collection week, or visit norfolkcounty.ca/CollectionDay.

Please, report stolen or damaged carts.

Damaged carts may not work with the automated waste collection trucks. If your carts become damaged, please contact ServiceNorfolk to arrange for repairs or replacement carts.

If your carts are **lost or stolen**, please contact ServiceNorfolk. Each cart has a serial number that assigns it to your address, so stolen carts can be checked and returned to their proper place.

Please, sort your waste.

Here is a list of what goes in your green cart... and what does not.

Waste Calendar October 2026 to March 2027

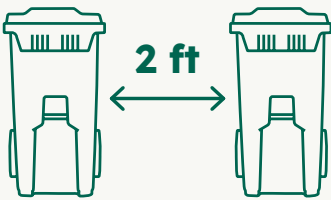
Please, set out your carts properly.

Carts must be set out properly to ensure they can be collected by the new automated waste collection trucks. Failing to set out your carts properly may result in your waste not being collected that week.



1. Face the street

Wheels should face your house, and the lid should open towards the street. Ensure the arrow on the cart lid faces the street.



2. Give them space

Carts should have 2' (60 cm) between them and other objects (trees, fire hydrants, parked cars, etc.), including other carts.



3. Be on time

All carts (and recycling containers) must be set out before 7 a.m. on collection day, and brought in by 7 p.m. that evening.



4. Close your cart lids

All waste must fit inside the cart with the lid closed. Waste set outside of your carts will not be collected.
