



Non-Recreational Fires Open Air By-Law



How do I get a permit?

You can obtain a permit at www.northperth.ca, Monday to Friday 8:30 am-4:30 pm on the Request Portal. Confirmation of the permit with a burn permit number is required before the fire is lit.



Must be at a safe distance of at least 30 metres (100 FT)



A burn permit is required for fires exceeding 3 metres (10FT) in diameter



Burn barrels are not permitted



Non-recreational fires are permitted during daylight hours only



Burning of rubber, plastic, household garbage, recyclables and materials that produce noxious odours is prohibited



A source of extinguishment is required at the site



Fires should not be started when the wind speed is predicted to exceed 20 km's per hour



Must be supervised by a competent person who is at least 18 years of age and has a method of communication in case of emergency



Non-recreational fires are only permitted in rural areas of the Municipality
