

Recreational Fires Open Air By-Law

No Permit Required



Permitted in both urban
and rural areas



The use of propane/natural gas units is permitted with
no less than 3 metres (10FT) distance from any
combustible material and an overhead clearance of 2.1
metres (7FT)



Fires should not be started when the wind speed is
predicted to exceed 20 Km's per hour



A garden hose must be in close proximity to the fire and
connected to a pressurized water source



The fire must be at a safe distance of at least 7.5 metres
(25FT) from any building, structure, or combustible
object. Recreational fires must be small and contained -
no more than 0.7m metres (30") in diameter and no more
than 1 metre (40") in height, including flame height.



Must be supervised by a competent person who is
at least 18 years of age



If burning wood, the wood
must be clean and dry,
burning of painted or
pressure treated wood and
any other construction
materials is prohibited



Burn barrels are
not permitted



Burning of rubber, plastic,
household garbage,
recyclable and materials that
produce noxious odours is
prohibited
