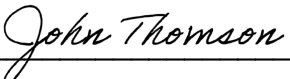

OSPSB GP-007 Flag Etiquette

It is the policy of the Owen Sound Police Service Board to treat the National Flag of Canada and other flags with dignity and respect in accordance with accepted flag etiquette.

The Chief of Police will:

- a) Develop procedures to guide Members on proper flag etiquette that address:
 - I. When appropriate flag raising ceremonies and/or flag lowering ceremonies may take place;
 - II. When flags are flown at half-mast position as a sign of mourning; and
 - III. Where flags are displayed inside a building.
- b) Ensure when a flag is no longer in a suitable condition for use, it shall be destroyed; and
- c) Take into consideration the City of Owen Sound's policy on flag etiquette when developing police services procedures.
