General Information

1. Costumes are encouraged, we appreciate the Christmas Spirit- however, Santa Claus is attending the parade. Please do not come dressed as Santa Claus.
2. All floats MUST match the pace of the vehicle in front of them.
3. Please ensure all float decorations are properly secured.
4. Please ensure all handouts are given directly to the spectators so as not to be thrown into the road and are not thrown from the floats.
5. Absolutely NO horns, air horns, or otherwise are to be sounded during the parade.
6. Float applications will be limited to one vehicle plus trailer. If you would like to enter additional vehicles, please email the Community Recreation Coordinator with your request. Town of Parry Sound Staff will approve additional vehicles based on availability one week in advance of the parade.
7. Children on Floats must be supervised by at least one adult.
8. All participants are to follow the one-way street up Gibson to join the floats. Please only drop off participants and do not park on the left side of the road. This will ease flow of floats and participants on Gibson Street
9. In the event of inclement weather leading to the cancellation of the Parade, it will be rescheduled for Tuesday, December 1st at 4:30 PM. The rescheduled parade will feature a shortened route focused within the Downtown core. Please identify in your submission if you're available for the reschedule date.

Driver Instructions During the Parade

1. Ensure driver's window is open at all times.
2. Maintain pace with the float in front.
3. Be prepared to start and stop regularly.
4. Please obey all parade marshals' instructions.
5. Please drive in the middle of the road.
6. Horns are not to be sounded- air horns included.
7. DO NOT cross the railway tracks unless you have enough space to cross completely.
8. If a train comes, obey all crossing signals, wait until the train is done then resume the parade at the same pace. Do not rush to catch up.
