Taxes can be paid through most financial institutions, by online banking, by mail, or in person at the County Complex. For online banking payments, use your property roll number as the account number. All 2026 Saddle Hills County Combined Assessment and Tax Notices are deemed received 7 days after the mailing date. The notice of assessment date is **May 21, 2026**.
