Qualifications of Electors

A person is entitled to vote in a municipal election if, on Voting Day, they:

- reside in the local municipality, or are the owner or tenant of land in the municipality, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- are a Canadian citizen, and
- are at least 18 years old, and
- are not prohibited from voting by law.

Voting Period

The Voting Period opens October 19, 2026 at 8:30 a.m. and closes October 26, 2026 at 8:00 p.m. Eligible electors can vote online and by telephone anytime during the Voting Period.

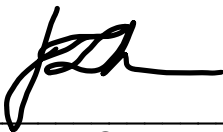
Voter Help Centre Location
