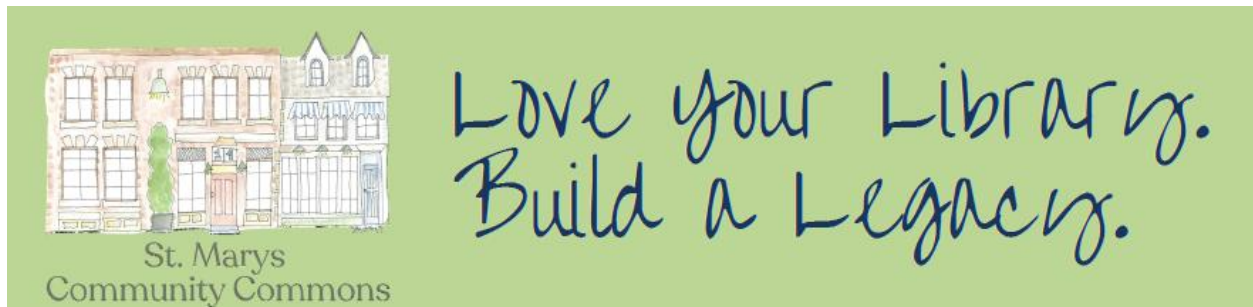

Dear Community Member,

The Library is spearheading the capital campaign for our new Community Commons project at 14 Church St. North and we would like to invite you to be a part of this dynamic project! The St. Marys Public Library is a core institution in town and continues to provide the community with access to diverse library collections, spaces, fun programs and services and engaging opportunities for lifelong learning since our doors opened in 1905. Library spaces are important to our residents and help to build a strong community. To continue to do this, we need to grow our spaces in the downtown core.

The Community Commons at 14 Church St. North will provide the Library specifically with space to grow our programming, technology, Maker Space, and general community spaces to meet and study, socialize and explore. Additionally, it will provide new spaces for our Adult Learning Program of Perth to offer their learning support services, host other community serves, and assist community members in town access to service providers like Ontario Works, CMHA, ODSP and Leads. The space will allow elevator access to storage space for the Friends of the Library book sales.

In addition to supporting library programming and services, the spaces will also allow for growth of programming by several town services including the Friendship Centre, recreation, and the museum. It will also offer our service clubs and town groups spaces to offer programming and allow room for growth.
