



Mayoral Decision

MDE-2026-009

July 28, 2026

Give written approval of By-Laws passed at the June 23, 2026 Council Meeting.

Under the Authority: Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 284.11 (Veto Powers):

By-law commencement

- (4) Despite any other Act, a by-law that is subject to this section shall be deemed not to have been passed by council until,
- (a) if notice has not been given under subsection (3), the earlier of,
 - (i) the day written approval of the by-law is given by the head of council to the municipality, and
 - (ii) two days after the day council voted in favour of the by-law or the prescribed deadline, as the case may be; or
 - (b) if notice has been given under subsection (3), the earlier of,
 - (i) the day written approval of the by-law is given by the head of council to the municipality, and
 - (ii) 14 days, or such other prescribed time period, after the day the council voted in favour of the by-law. 2022, c. 18, Sched. 2, s. 1.

Veto powers

- (5) Subject to subsection (6), if the head of council is of the opinion that all or part of the by-law could potentially interfere with a prescribed provincial priority, the head of council may veto the by-law by providing to the clerk, on the day of the veto, a written veto document that includes the veto and the reasons for the veto. 2022, c. 18, Sched. 2, s. 1; 2022, c. 24, Sched. 3, s. 7.

Same, timing

- (6) The head of council shall not veto a by-law after giving approval under subclause (4) (b) (i) or after the expiry of the time period described in subclause (4) (b) (ii), as the case may be. 2022, c. 18, Sched. 2, s. 1.

Under this authority, the Mayor has decided as follows:

1. The Mayor will not exercise the power to veto the by-laws passed at the July 28, 2026 Council meeting.
2. This Mayoral Decision provides written notice to approve these by-laws:
 - a. **By-law No. 2026-057:** A By-law to Designate Community Safety Zones and Repeal By-law No. 2019-111.
 - b. **By-law No. 2026-058:** A By-law to Repeal By-law No. 2022-119 and By-law No. 2023-136, Respecting an Agreement with the Campbellford Rebels.
 - c. **By-law No. 2026-059:** A By-law for establishing and assuming a municipal highway, Being Part of Lots 11 and 12, Concession 8, being Part 1 of Plan 39R-15170, a portion of Richardson Road, geographic Township of Percy, Municipality of Trent Hills, County of Northumberland.
 - d. **By-law No. 2026-060:** A By-law for establishing and assuming a municipal highway, Being Part of Lot 26, Concession 7, being Part 1 on Plan 39R-15149, a portion of the 8th Line East; and Part of Lot 26, Concession 7, being Part 3 on Plan 39R-15149, a portion of Wingfield Road, geographic Township of Seymour, Municipality of Trent Hills, County of Northumberland.
 - e. **By-law No. 2026-061:** A By-law to amend the Zoning Provision which applies to land in Part of Lot 26, Concession 9, geographic Township of Seymour, Municipality of Trent Hills C08/2026.
 - f. **By-law No. 2026-062:** A By-law to authorize execution of a Community Improvement Plan Program Agreement between The Corporation of the Municipality of the Trent Hills and John Hannah tenant of 27 Main Street, Warkworth.
 - g. **By-law No. 2026-063:** A By-law to authorize execution of a Community Improvement Plan Program Agreement between The Corporation of the Municipality of the Trent Hills and Marlene Cottrell Owner of 33 Front Street N., Campbellford.
 - h. **By-law No. 2026-065:** A By-law to Appoint a Deputy Treasurer and to Repeal By-law 2022-138.
 - i. **By-law No. 2026-064:** A By-law to Confirm the Proceedings of the Council meeting held on Tuesday, July 28, 2026.
3. This Mayoral Decision comes into effect on July 28, 2026.
